CHEYENNE VILLAGE Companion Home Provides Support and Fosters Independence

Sisters Betsy and Jeani have sons, Kirk and Craig, who have been served by Cheyenne Village for more than 25 years. Before coming to Cheyenne Village, their family spent many years on the road to a diagnosis. Along the way, they were given several theories including hyperactivity, autism and mental illness -- but never a definitive answer.

However, in the early 90s, a friend of the family attended a conference in Denver on Fragile X syndrome and suggested that the cousins be tested. After DNA testing, the family received the bittersweet news that Craig and Kirk indeed had Fragile X syndrome. It was a relief to finally have an answer, but it was devastating to know that while Betsy and Jeani were not affected by the syndrome -- they were carriers of the gene that they had passed along to their sons.

Kirk and Craig joined Cheyenne Village when they turned 21 and moved into a group home. In 2014, when Cheyenne Village launched its first Companion Home -- a supported living model for individuals who can live somewhat independently but want 24/7 support -- the cousins moved into one side of the Companion Home duplex. Their support companion, Nancy, lives on the other side. "They love their home, yard, and dog Sadie. They have a real sense of belonging and independence," said Kirk's mom Jeani. "Nancy gives them the responsibility to clean their rooms, make coffee, and help with yard work. They are so happy and we have seen real growth."

Our Work

- **The need for Cheyenne Village's services continues to increase, with enrollment growing 12 percent in 2015.**
- **28 percent of the individuals served have been with Cheyenne Village more than 20 years of their lives.**
- **Last year, Cheyenne Village provided more than 6,500 hours of respite to families and caregivers.**
- **67 percent of the individuals served fall below the Federal Poverty Guidelines.**
- **Cheyenne Village provides care and services across the adult lifespan to more than 400 individuals in the Pikes Peak Region ranging in age from 18 to 82.**

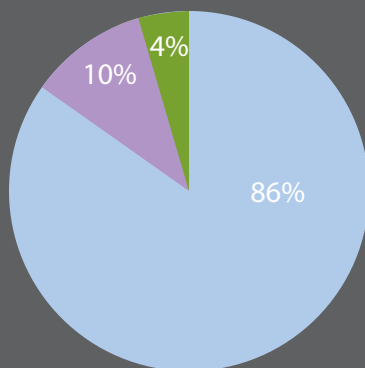
