


Dear Supporters of Cheyenne Village:

In 2021, all of us at Cheyenne Village were excited to have celebrated our 50th Anniversary of serving individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) in our community. People with disabilities have value and contribute to the social and economic environment of the community. People with disabilities have the right to develop relationships, pursue personal growth, experience self-respect, and exert control over their lives. They are entitled to the same civil liberties as persons without disabilities.

This was the vision of our founder Peggy Marshall, and it is still our vision today and for many years to come. You have made this possible with your support either through volunteering or contributions. To see this vision, we have included some of our history in this annual report. We also shared it throughout 2021 on Facebook and at www.CheyenneVillage.org. Here is just a brief snapshot of the last fifty years:





The 1970s

After years of extensive research, Peggy Marshall and a group of concerned Colorado Springs citizens founded Cheyenne Village, Inc. in 1971 at McLaughlin Family Lodge in Manitou Springs, Colorado. Here, the twelve participants would live and learn, working alongside staff in the day-today operation of the lodge, greeting the guests, cleaning the cabins and grooming the 15-acre grounds. Individually tailored program plans provided training in living skills, self-care, transportation, and job skills.

News of this innovative venture spread quickly throughout the community. By the end of the year, thirty young adults were enrolled in the Cheyenne Village program. The reputation of Cheyenne Village continued to grow. By the end of the decade, one-hundred and twenty persons, representing thirteen states, were enrolled at Cheyenne Village.

The 1980s

The 1980s was a decade of change in philosophy in order to meet the service delivery individuals expected. Persons with disabilities began to advocate for individual choice in determining their lifestyles. To meet this need, Cheyenne Village created The Apartment Living Program, which offered more independence for an individual than living in a group home.

The 1990s

As demand for age-related and medically fragile services increased, it was necessary that homes were built to accommodate those demands. The original home was the first fully accessible home in Colorado designed specifically for wheelchair users and medically fragile individuals.

The 2000s

Since 2000, Cheyenne Village has expanded healthcare support. This was necessary due to the population aging and developing age-related medical conditions. Nurses and drivers who transport individuals to medical, dental and laboratory appointments were hired to ensure healthcare was provided and coordinated across many medical professionals.

In February 2006, founder Peggy Marshall passed away. A commemorative video was made of an interview filmed for the 35th Anniversary.

In 2016, The Cheyenne Village Board of Directors decided to develop alternative housing options and to discontinue the use of McLaughlin Lodge due to the challenges of maintaining the aging property and to promote inclusive community living.

Today

McLaughlin Lodge was sold in January of 2021, and we have purchased three homes in Colorado Springs and plan to purchase a fourth. Today, we serve approximently 400 individuals living in the Pikes Peak Region.

We hope you enjoyed reading about our journey and we thank you for your support.




