

Celebrating the Life and Legacy of Michael Heath September 13, 1947 - January 4, 2025



Mike Heath was served by Cheyenne Village for 38 years. He was a man driven by a deep desire to make a difference. His motivation led him to become a prominent figure in local politics and various advocacy groups. Mike's passion for fighting for the rights of individuals with various disabilities, including those with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), was evident in many of his endeavors.

One of the key issues Mike championed was the need for reliable transportation for people with disabilities. His advocacy took him to the Colorado State Capitol, where he passionately discussed the matter at a hearing. Mike was never one to shy away from expressing his opinions and was known to write directly to the Governor expressing the challenges faced by people with disabilities.

Mike's involvement with Cheyenne Village spanned 38 years, during which he contributed to numerous projects. He was particularly proud of the *Grapevine Newsletter*, a publication created by and for the

clients of Cheyenne Village. As an editor, Mike played a crucial role in writing announcements and covering current events within the community. He also penned a recurring article called "Dreamers Corner," where he encouraged others in the Cheyenne Village family to share their personal goals and aspirations.

In addition to his advocacy and editorial work, Mike was a talented artist. He had a passion for black and white photography, painting, and exploring various forms of art. His creativity and artistic expression were a significant part of his identity.

Mike's dedication to Cheyenne Village helped shape the client-focused culture that the organization is known for today. Despite battling declining health in his later years, Mike continued to be an integral part of the Cheyenne Village family, residing in the Pearl Group Home.

On January 4, 2025, Mike Heath passed away, leaving behind a legacy of compassion, advocacy, and creativity. His contributions to the community and his commitment

to making a difference will be remembered and cherished by all who knew him.

Rest in peace, Mike. Thank you for your tireless efforts and the lasting impact you've made.




